Within the framework of the European Security and Defense College (ESDC), Italy has the great honour to organise a course on the "Civilian aspects of EU crisis management", to be held in Rome from 24th to 28th November 2014. - ❖ The course is open to both, civilian and military personnel from EU-Member States, EU institutions/Agencies and CSDP Missions, who are invited to attend with two participants each.
- ❖ Applications are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST (<https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/ENList/web/app.php/login>), by designated nominators, **no later than October 30th 2014**. Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the registration form by the nominated participant.
- ❖ The course venue is CASD – Palazzo Salviati, Piazza della Rovere 83 – 00165 ROME (Italy)
- ❖ The language regime of the CSDP will apply, i.e. the working languages are English and French and no translation will be provided.
- ❖ Attendance of the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded to those course participants who have completed the full course, including the IDL phase.
- ❖ All costs for travelling, accommodation and catering shall be covered by the sending authorities.
