CODE OF CONDUCT

The code must be understood by all ICC participants & a parent or guardian

The ICC is a two-week 'alcohol and drug free' event bringing together young people from different nationalities. As a participant of the ICC, it is essential that you understand that the following points need to be adhered to.

Participants will be expected to:

1. Fully participate in all daytime and evening activities;
2. Behave in a responsible manner whilst undertaking activities;
3. Be courteous and supportive to other group members and staff;
4. Understand certain areas and all other participant bedrooms are restricted to authorized staff only;
5. Be punctual for all activities;
6. Communicate in English;
7. Ensure bedrooms are kept tidy;
8. Be responsible for one's personal belongings;
9. Smoke (if applicable) only in designated smoking areas;
10. Any kind of sexual relations are forbidden;
11. Inform group leaders of any concerns/problems as soon as possible.
12. Take responsibility for any damage caused by their own actions, including its cost.

The key word for the success of ICC is **RESPECT**. If we all show **RESPECT** to all other participants, group leaders, instructors and resources, the camp will be a fantastic experience.

All participants have to accept the staff's authority!

Any young person whose behaviour is of an unacceptable standard will be dealt with by the Camp Director who has the licence to send participants home at their parent's expense.
