CODE OF CONDUCT

The code must be understood by all ICC group leaders

The ICC is a two-week 'alcohol and drug free' event bringing together underage young people from different nationalities. As a group leader of the ICC, it is essential that you understand that the following points needs to be adhered to.

Group leaders will be expected to:

- 1. Fully participate in the organization frame of all daytime and evening activities as well as everyday life, such as oversee all meal times, control bedrooms property, hygiene and health;
- 2. Behave in a responsible manner during all stay while undertaking activities and serve as an example of behaviour to the participants;
- 3. Be courteous and supportive to other group members and staff;
- 4. Be punctual for all activities, meals, staff meetings, and others in the time schedule of the camp;
- 5. Communicate in English;
- 6. Smoke (if applicable) only in designated smoking areas;
- 7. Any kind of sexual relations between adults and minors are forbidden;
- 8. All the adults have to adopt an exemplary behaviour without ambiguity and show discretion in their relationships;
- 9. Inform the Director of the Camp and other group leaders of any concerns/problems as soon as possible;
- 10. Uphold and enforce the code of conduct by all the young participants;
- 11. Respect the culture, values and rules of the host nation at all time in the camp;
- 12. Treat the participants in a correct and respectful manner.

The key word for the success of ICC is **RESPECT**. If we all show **RESPECT** to <u>all</u> young participants, group leaders, instructors and resources, the camp will be a fantastic experience.

All group leaders have to accept the host country authority!
