

ROMA CENTOCELLE

Location:

Rome is in the Lazio region of central Italy, at the confluence of the Aniene and Tiber (Italian: Tevere) rivers. Although the city center is about 24 kilometers inland from the Tyrrhenian Sea, the city territory extends to the very shore, where the south-western Ostia district is located. The altitude of Rome ranges from 13 meters above sea level (in Piazza del Popolo) to 120 meters above sea level (the peak of Monte Mario). The comune of Rome covers an overall area of about 1,285 square kilometers, including many green areas.

Resort facilities:

The lodgings are inside the Military Airport of Centocelle.

The lodgings are furnished with a double bed and a sofa (suitable only for 1 adult or 2 small children). They have a cooking area, private services, TV set and fridge. The guests can enjoy a Mess, an NCO Club with a bar, a tennis court, a five-a-side ground and a gym.

Check-in and check out

Check-in within 22:00 hrs on the first day of the assigned period. Check-out within 09:00 a.m. on the last assigned day.

Payments:

In cash only.

How to get there:

- By car: on the Motorway A1 take exit Roma G.R.A. (G.R.A. is a 70 km. long ring around the city) then exit nr. 21 "Tuscolana" (towards city centre);
- By train: from the train station (Roma Termini) take the underground (Linea "A") station "Numidio Quadrato" and then 10 minutes by feet to the airport;
- By plane: from Fiumicino Airport take the shuttle to the train station then see above.
