CODE OF CONDUCT

The code must be understood and accepted by all ICC participants & parents or guardians

The ICC is a two-week 'smoke, vape, alcohol and drug free' event bringing together young people from different nationalities. As a participant of the ICC, it is essential that you understand that the following points need to be adhered to.

Participants will be expected to:

1. Fully participate in all daytime and evening activities
2. Behave in a responsible manner whilst undertaking activities
3. Be courteous and supportive to other group members and staff, respect and follow group leaders' instructions
4. Understand certain areas are restricted to authorized staff only
5. Be punctual for all activities
6. Communicate in English
7. Ensure bedrooms are kept tidy
8. Follow the COVID safety measures
9. Be responsible for one's personal belongings
10. Bringing into the camp and consume of alcohol and any type of drugs is permanently and strictly forbidden
11. Not have any sexual relations neither among participants nor with participants of other groups nor with any adults
12. Inform group leaders of any concerns/problems as soon as possible
13. In case of a pandemic a teamer will have to be informed immediately as soon as any symptoms of illness occur. All measures given by the local authorities will have to be accepted and observed.

The key word for the success of ICC is **RESPECT**. If we all show **RESPECT** to all other participants, group leaders, instructors and resources, the camp will be a fantastic experience.

All participants have to accept the staff's authority!

Any young person whose behaviour is of an unacceptable standard will be dealt with by the Camp Director who has the authority to send participants home at their parents' expense. Any actions of illegal nature such as theft, purchase or consumption of alcohol or any kind of drugs including nicotine, racist comments or actions, bullying, violence or sexual harassment will lead to the immediate release of the participant from the camp.
