The order of activities may change depending on weather, availability of attractions on a given day, etc. They may also be changed to other equivalent ones.



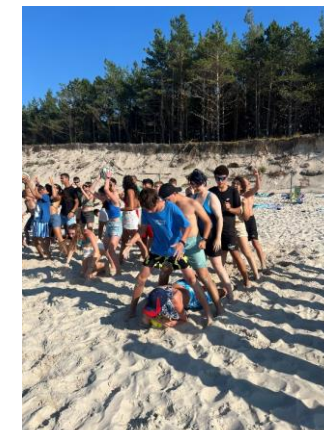

PRICE INCLUDES:

- **ACCOMODATION:** Holiday resort Rewita Rogowo Building „Agatka”. Rooms for 3-4 persons (single beds, tv, fridge, chairs, table), shared bathroom for two rooms or bathroom in the room (rooms after renovation).
- **BOARDING:** Three buffet meals and afternoon tea served before dinner (fruits, snacks). Sparkling or still water dispensed at breakfast. Camp starts with dinner (in a case of earlier arrival there will be prepared a packed lunch for group) and ends with lunch (breakfast in canteen and packed lunch for the road instead of lunch in the canteen). During all-day trip to Szczecin we provide packed lunches.
- **PROGRAM & LOCAL TRANSPORT** (Kołobrzeg-Rogowo-Kołobrzeg on arrival/departures days and transport during the camp).

EXTRA PAID: Transport on the arrival/departure day: possible variants from/to airports in Berlin, Gdańsk or Szczecin





LOCATION AND TRAVEL

- **Rogowo is located between the Baltic Sea and the Resko Przymorskie lake.**
- REWITA Rogowo resort is situated right by the sea, in a quiet and peaceful village between Mrzeżyno and Dźwirzyno, only 18 kilometers from the well-known health resort - Kołobrzeg. The place is located far from crowded resorts.
- A charming town, a wide beach with golden sand, peace, quiet and the possibility of full contemplation of nature. Our guests enjoy a private entrance to the beach.
- The area around the center is fenced and supervised.

- The nearest train station: Kołobrzeg - 18 km from Rogowo
- The nearest airport: Szczecin Goleniów - 80 km from Rogowo
- Airport in: Gdańsk (Lech Walesa Airport) - 260 km from Rogowo
- Airport in: Berlin - 275 km from Rogowo
