Requests for information, among others, from the European Union Military Staff, US Department of Defense, Australian Ministry of Defense.

2018

Future of Warfare: Artificial Intelligence

Workshop devised to generate some ideas for a possible NATO AI Strategy. Participants included some of the leading roboticists, economists, historians, international lawyers and practitioners in the world on artificial intelligence. Few months later NATO HQ started working on an AI Strategy.
