These guidelines have been prepared in compliance with the provisions on the "Protection of copyright and other rights related to its exercise" (Italian Law no. 633 of 22 April 1941).

The articles' authors, accepting the conditions of the rules, transfer to "Journal of Military Medicine" the right of economic use of the intellectual work(s), the intellectual property of which remains to the Author and with the limitations deriving from the attribution of the aforementioned right of publication.

The documents intended for publication must comply with the constraints of the Code regarding the protection of personal data (Legislative Decree of 30 June, no. 196 and the GDPR, EU Regulation 2016/679, whose Data Processor is the General Inspectorate of Military Health – via di Santo Stefano Rotondo n. 4 – 00187 ROME -) as well as those deriving from the legislation on State Secrets and those relating to the prohibition of publication

confidential/controlled/classified information within NATO-EU and/or national context.

The collaboration is open to all authors who enjoy civil and political rights in their country. The responsibility for the actual ownership of these rights falls within the personal sphere of the Author who declares to be in possession of them.

Editorial products intended for publication must be unpublished and free from editorial constraints.

Acceptance is previously evaluated by the opinion of the Scientific Committee and the Board of Reviewers. The scientific articles (e.g. original study, review, case report) are subjected to a *single blind peer review* process entrusted to the competent members of the Board of Reviewers, which accept or reject the work or requesting for modification. The notification of acceptance or rejecting shall be communicated to the authors. During the peer review process, the Scientific Committee may ask an opinion to the experts of the Editorial Board on whether or not to publish an article. It is recommended that the paper be sent already accompanied by the favorable opinion of the hierarchical superiors, where applicable.

A preferential condition for the publication is that at least one of the authors is a member of the Military Health Services, Guardia di Finanza, Police, Italian Red Cross

The Journal accepts for publication scientific papers, scientific communications/clinical cases/short notes, editorials (by invitation only) and any other relevant scientific or military contribution. All authors are responsible for the content of the text and that the work has not been published or simultaneously submitted to other

journals for publication. Once accepted, the works become the property of the Journal and may not be published in whole or in part elsewhere without the permission of the Publisher.

It is required to send a short curriculum vitae and the references of all the Authors and the contact point of the Author responsible for the paper (e.g. address, mobile phone., fax, e-mail).

The articles, photos and computer supports will remain in the records of the Editorial Board, not returned even if not published.

The submission of the papers implies the observance by the Author, without any reservation, of all the rules, conditions and constraints referred to in these rules, as well as the presentation of the declarations at the same time as the elaboration and failure to comply with them will result in automatic exclusion from the procedure. For anything not expressly provided for in these Regulations, reference is made to the rules dictated by the relevant legislation and subsequent/related legislative and/or regulatory provisions.

Pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679 and Legislative Decree 2018/101, we inform you that the personal data provided by the Authors will be used exclusively for the completion of the procedure in question. In particular, the Author may exercise the right to access personal data, request its correction, integration, or any other right contemplated by the aforementioned decree.
