Vallecrosia is a town on the Ligurian Riviera, located by the mouth of the stream Verbone (also called Crosia) between Bordighera and Ventimiglia. It's about 12km from the French border, 40km from Imperia and 15km from San Remo, where the main resort can be found. Its geographical position and the mild climate that blesses the "Flower Riviera" all year round make Vallecrosia a holiday destination both during the summer season, thanks to its wonderful, 1km. long, pebble beach, and during the winter months. Musical evenings and a variety of other entertainment are organized within the resort itself. An interesting market takes place in the small squares in the historical centre of upper Vallecrosia on the second Sunday of each month.

How to reach the base

By Car: Take A10 motorway and exit at Bordoghera towards Vallecrosia. Alternatively you can take Aurelia street which goes through the city.

By Train: Get off at Bordighera station and take one of the many buses towards Vallecrosia.
