

The base is located near the historical center and just a few steps from the sea. The structure has comfortable apartments with kitchens so you can cook your own meals. The structure organizes evening entertainment, such as dancing, music, karaoke, and films. The town also offers a variety of activities which includes shows, concerts, and fairs. The nearest sandy beach is 30 m from the base. However, the beach with which the base has an agreement is 50 m away. Near Cefalù you can explore the Madonie and Nebrodi national parks. In town you can visit the famous cathedral, built during the Norman period under Ruggero II. It's said that he built the cathedral after making a vow in return for safe passage during a furious storm. His prayers were answered and he was able to dock his ships near modern Cefalù. The church was started in 1131, but it took over a century to finish. With a spectacular background of cliffs, it boasts majestic towers and mosaics from the 12th century.

How the reach the Base

By Car: From Messina take the A20 motorway towards Palermo for about 160 km. Take the exit for Cefalù.

By Train: Get off at the Cefalù station from trains on the Palermo – Messina line.

By Plane: The most convenient airports to reach Cefalù are in Palermo or Catania.

By Boat: Use the Palermo port where you can get connections to Rome, Livorno, Genoa, or Naples via high – speed ferry.
