Tourism

Palau is a small town located in the area of Gallura, (Northern Sardinia). During summer it becomes a very crowded place, with its port where ferry-boats linking Sardinia to La Maddalena and its Archipelago. On the East Coast, 3 miles from the city centre, we can find the famous rock called "the Bear" looking out onto the sea that due to the wind and coastal erosion, has taken the shape of a "Bear".

General Information

The accommodation in Palau consists of 1(one) apartment with 5 (five) beds.

There are: a living dining room with a double-bedded sofa; a bedroom with a king-size bed; a room with a sofa bed; a well equipped kitchen; a bathroom with shower, beach umbrellas and an exterior table with some small armchairs.

There is air conditioner and satellite TV (free).

Moreover, the accommodation is in the downtown core 50 yards near the commercial port and only a half

mile from one of the most beautiful beaches of Palau, called "La Sciumara", where you can admire La Maddalena Archipelago. In addition, in about 30 minutes it is possible to reach the Emerald Coast.

How To Arrive

by plane: with a stop in Olbia;

by ferry-boat: boarding Civitavecchia — arrival Olbia. Drive on the SS125 main road towards Palau-Santa Teresa, for about 40 miles.

There is a regular bus service from Olbia to Palau., and daily ferries service Palau-La Maddalena on: www.enermar.it - www.saremar.it
