## **Organizational Setting and Reporting :**

The post of Logistics Medical Officer is located in the Department of Operational Support (DOS), Office of Supply Chain Management (OSCM), Logistics Division (LD), Sourcing Support Service, Medical Support Section (MSS). The Logistics Medical Officer (Military) directly reports to the Chief of Unit, Medical Support.

## **Responsibilities :**

Within delegated authority, the Logistics Medical Officer (Military) will be responsible for the following:

- Provides logistics support for new and ongoing peacekeeping and other field missions includes: supply chain management, materials management, transportation, maintenance, medical contracts and services management.
- Prepares medical logistics and support plans, deployment timelines and budget requirements for planned or new peacekeeping missions. Develops medical logistical plans for existing missions.
- Develops medical contingency plans for drawdown and liquidation of missions.
- Develops and implements methodologies and tools to enable effective execution of medical logistic plans.
- Formulates specific Standard Operating Procedures, tools, and guidelines related to medical logistics, and updates the Healthcare Category Strategy.
- Manages medical logistics operations including medical equipment, pharmaceuticals, consumables, laboratory supplies, blood products, and integrated turnkey medical service solutions and ensures timely, accountable and cost-effective delivery.
- Ensures that supervised staff are adequately trained, cross trained; identifies additional training needs to achieve high working standards as relevant.
- Coordinates and provides the end-to-end medical supply chain by monitoring availability, stock levels, movements, and distribution of medical supplies, for timely deployment.
- Ensures that medical logistics requirements take account of gender-specific needs.
- Coordinates with procurement to develop, update, and maintain standardized technical specifications for medical equipment, consumables, and services in line with internationally recognized quality standards,
- Contributes to continuous quality assurance and technical compliance of medical goods and services used in UN operations.
- Advises on legal and financial aspects of the mission, as relevant.
- Develops and implements the healthcare strategy within the DOS logistics support policy, procedures and methodologies to the common benefit of all functional units.
- Prepares reports on personnel and materiel movements and other operational logistics issues as relevant
- Contributes to the collection, analysis, and reporting of medical logistics data.
- Participates in technical survey missions and verification missions to troop contributing

- countries, as relevant.
- Identifies plans and manages special logistics operations.
- Ensures that accurate and complete accounting, reporting and internal control systems are functioning and that all relevant records are maintained, as relevant.
- Prepares contingency plans and logistics and/or emergency preparedness
- Coordinates medical logistics operations with internal stakeholders, other UN agencies, military and other organisations in the field and provides technical advice as required.
- Performs other related duties as required.
- Undertake these or similar duties anywhere within UN Headquarters as well as in field missions including deployment to the missions for up to 90 days at a time.

## **Competencies :**

**Professionalism:** Knowledge of medical logistics support planning, and medical equipment management Demonstrates professional competence and mastery of supply chain for medical commodities; Is conscientious and efficient in meeting commitments, observing deadlines and achieving results; Shows persistence when faced with difficult problems or challenges; Remains calm in stressful situations. Solid computer skills and good knowledge of relevant medical databases. Takes responsibility for incorporating gender perspectives and ensuring the equal participation of women and men in all areas of work.

**Planning and Organizing:** Develops clear goals that are consistent with agreed strategies; identifies priority activities and assignments; adjusts priorities as required; allocates appropriate amount of time and resources for completing work; foresees risks and allows for contingencies when planning; monitors and adjusts plans and actions as necessary; uses time efficiently.

**Teamwork:** Works collaboratively with colleagues to achieve organizational goals; solicits input by genuinely valuing others' ideas and expertise; is willing to learn from others; places team agenda before personal agenda; supports and acts in accordance with final group decision, even when such decisions may not entirely reflect own position; shares credit for team accomplishments and accepts joint responsibility for team shortcomings.

## **Qualifications :**

### **Education**

Advanced university degree (Master's degree or equivalent degree) in one of the following fields: Health/Medical Logistics, Supply Chain Management with a healthcare focus, Health Administration or Health Services Management, Logistics, or Operations Management with demonstrated application to healthcare or military medical logistics. A first-level university degree (Bachelor's or equivalent) in Pharmacy, Medicine, Nursing, Healthcare Logistics, Biomedical Sciences, Biomedical Engineering, Health Systems Management, or any healthcare-related field, in combination with two additional years of qualifying experience may be accepted in lieu of the advanced university degree. Graduation from a National Command and Staff College is highly desirable.

### **Experience:**

A minimum of five (5) years of progressively responsible professional experience in medical logistics, healthcare supply chain management, or health support operations or a related field is required. Qualifying years of experience are calculated following the graduation from the national military/defense college or academy.

Applicant must be an active service military officer in the rank of Major or equivalent in other services for at least one year.

At least two (2) years of experience in medical logistics operations, including end-to-end supply chain management of medical commodities such as pharmaceuticals, medical equipment, consumables, laboratory items, and blood products is required.

At least two (2) years of experience supporting procurement and contract management processes for healthcare goods and services, including supplier performance monitoring, as well as support to contingency and/or surge operations is required.

A minimum of one (1) year of progressive experience in the provision of medical logistics and supply chain support services in complex, volatile, conflict, or post-conflict environments is desirable.

Demonstrated experience in medical logistics database management, including the application of statistical analysis for planning, monitoring, and reporting purposes is desirable.

### **Languages**

English and French are the working languages of the United Nations Secretariat. For the position(s) advertised, fluency in English and French is required. Knowledge of another official United Nations language is an advantage.

### **Assessment Method :**

Kindly note that you may, as part of the evaluation of your application for this position, be requested to undergo written knowledge-based or technical assessment exercises, which may be followed by a competency-based interview depending on the result of the written test.

### **Special Notice :**

Circulation of this Job Opening is limited to the Member States of the United Nations. Only active serving military personnel who are currently employed in their national military service and who have received authorization from their respective national authority to apply for this Job Opening will be considered.

Please note that during their secondment to the United Nations, military personnel are not eligible for reassignment or transfer to any other position within the Department of Peace Operations (DPO) or other parts of the UN Secretariat. Active-duty seconded personnel may serve under a UN Secretariat staff contract for a period of up to three years (cumulative), which, in exceptional cases, can be extended for a fourth and final year subject to operational needs and satisfactory performance. This service limit includes periods of any prior services with the United Nations as an active-duty seconded officer under a UN Secretariat staff contract.

Candidates who have previously served as active-duty seconded personnel may reapply after a break in service of at least one year from their last secondment under a UN Secretariat staff contract, subject to the contract limitation as indicated above.

Nominations of currently serving active-duty seconded military personnel on a UN Secretariat staff contract will not be considered.

Candidates must meet all the requirements of the Job Opening at the time of nomination in order to be considered for the position.

Nominations of women candidate are highly encouraged.
